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- 1960: Al Jolley graduates from Columbia High School (CHS) in Maplewood, NJ
- 1963?: Al enrolls in Wesleyan University's Master of Arts in Teaching program
- 1966: Al is assigned by Wesleyan to teach to teach math at Staples HS (SHS) in Westport, CT, and is later becomes full-time teacher
- 1968: First Ultimate game at CHS
- 1970: Al's younger sister, a CHS student, mails him a copy of CHS's Ultimate Rules
- 1971: Al founds the SHS Ultimate team
- 1972: First SHS interscholastic Ultimate game against Weston High School (CT), also purported to be the first co-ed sports event in the nation
- 1973: SHS beats CHS. On the SHS team were "Johnny Appleseeds" Bob Lacy '73, Ron Kaufman '74 and Greg Mead '74
- 1973 Bob Lacy enrolls at Wesleyan
- 1974 Buckley and Davis found UConn's team, Kaufman founds Brown's Ultimate team
- 1975 Bob Lacy founds the Wesleyan team, Wesleyan beats UConn 15-11 in their first game
